if I can play next to them.

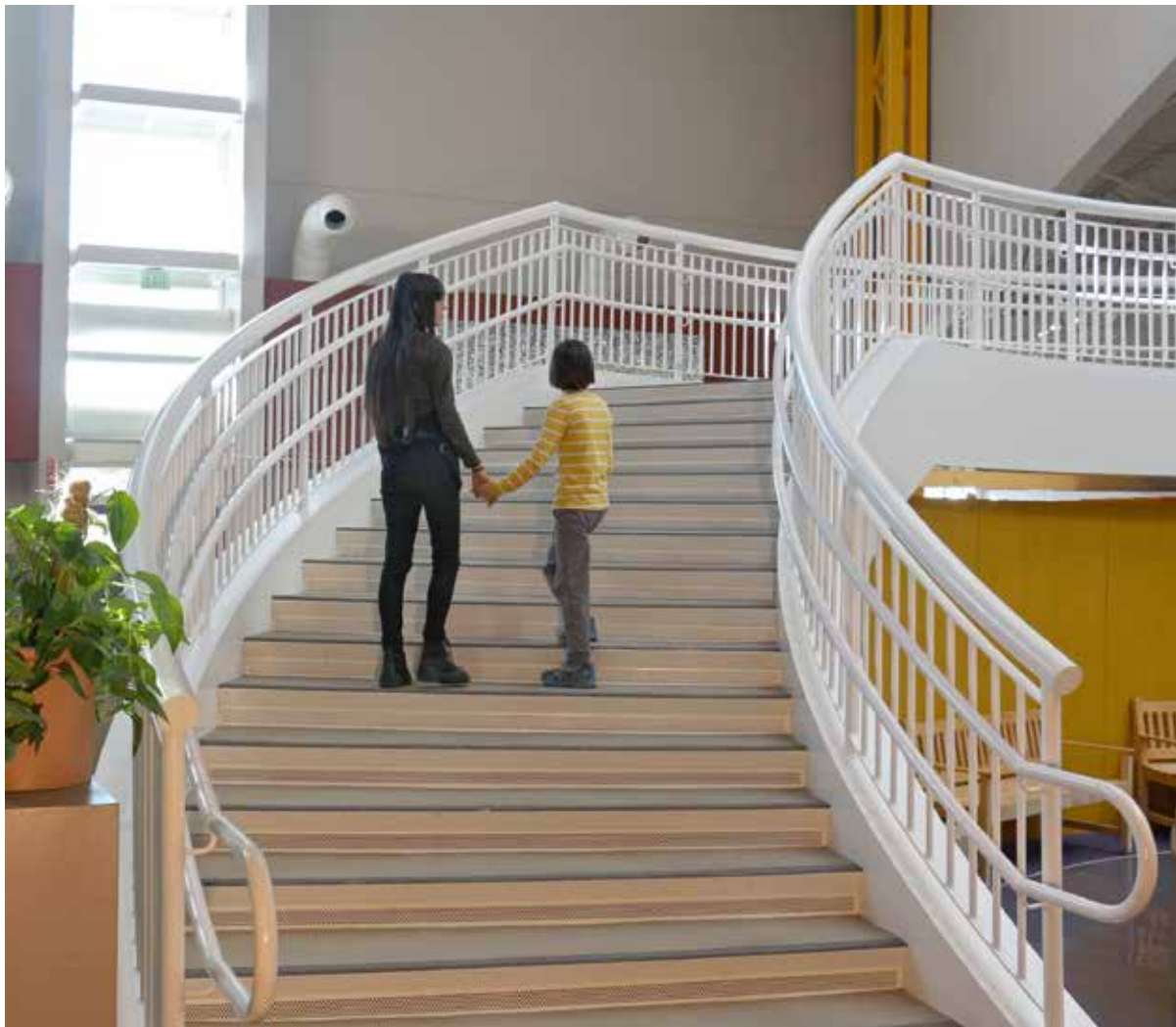


Some things in Explora might be closed while they are being repaired.

I will tell my adult so we can go together.

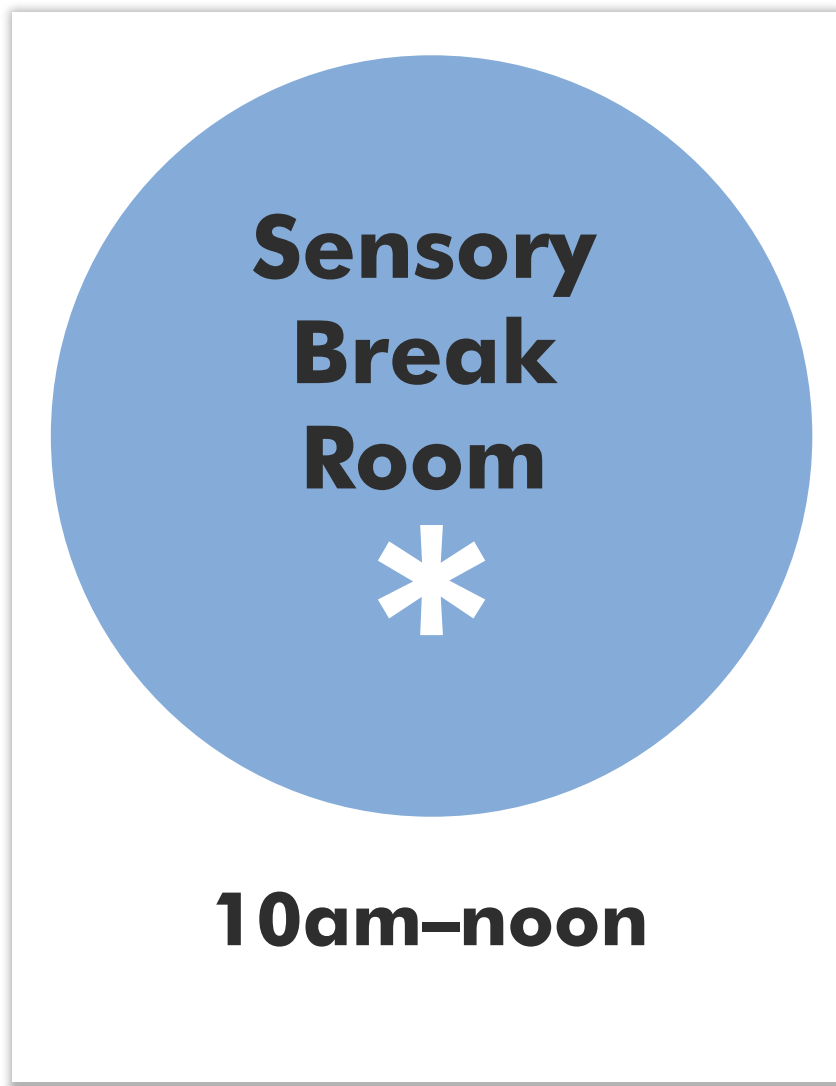




To get upstairs, I can use the staircase or I can take the elevator. The elevator is big, dark, and loud, but it's a fun ride and doesn't last too long.



There are places where I can go to take a break. When I see this sign, I know this a good place to take a break.

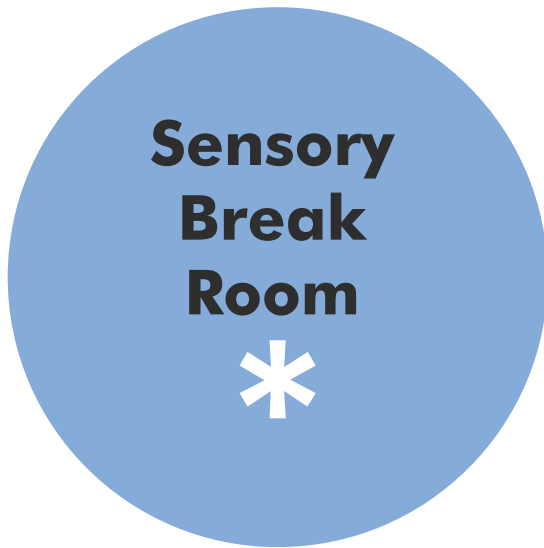


Explora is a fun place to visit,

going on at once.


If I get overwhelmed, I can:

go outside,




