


Explora Camp Guide



Pick-up and Drop-off: Drive Up




Form a car queue behind the “Camp and Program Entrance” sign, close to the Mountain Road entrance drive. A staff member will check your camper in/out from the car. Say in your vehicle while checking in/out and while you wait for your camper to exit.

Pick-up and Drop-off: Walk Up

If possible, drop off and pick up your camper from the car. If you prefer to walk up, park in the parking lot and walk your camper to the Camp Entrance. The parking lot can be full during peak hours!



Anyone picking up a child will need to be on the “approved” list that you supplied when registering, and must show ID.



What to Bring to Camp

- A reusable water bottle
- Nut-free snacks for break times- if your camper is staying all day, pack a snack for both AM and PM breaks
- A nut-free lunch
- Weather appropriate clothing; breaks will happen outdoors
- Labeled belongings
- Bathroom skills! All Explora campers must be able to use the restroom on their own

12:00-1:00 - Lunchtime and exhibit play*

12:45-1:00 - Afternoon camp drop-off
mid-afternoon- Snack and play break
3:55-4:15 - Camp pick-up
4:00-5:30 - Aftercare
